

# *Investment Meets Opportunity*

**Did you know?** The amount of college scholarships and aid received by Carmel Catholic graduates often far outweighs the amount their families paid in high school tuition.



On average, the Class of 2020 was awarded more than \$60,000 per graduate toward their chosen four-year undergraduate program.



Carmel has **increased their financial assistance making more than \$2 million dollars** in assistance available.



**1 in 4** Carmel students receive financial aid.



The average financial aid award per qualifying student is **\$5,744**.



Carmel has expanded the scope of **merit scholarships to recognize the top 10%** of entrance exam scorers by providing four-year renewable scholarships.

# *Tuition. Fees. Flexibility.*

Tuition for the 2020-2021 academic year is \$12,950. Fees for athletics, certain classes and course materials, as well as some clubs are additional.

Flexible Payment Plans: Carmel Catholic works with each family individually to design their plan. Families can choose:

- Monthly Payments: processed via bank draft and budgeted over ten months from July through April. Finance and service charges apply.
- Two Payments: due at the beginning of each semester – July and December.
- Paid in Full: \$100 discount if paid in full payment by July 1st.
