

St. Gilbert School uses Securly Content Filtering to block access to inappropriate websites and material on school-owned devices.

In addition to filtering harmful content, Securly's AI analyzes students' online activity—such as searches, websites visited, or emails sent and received—to help identify potential signs of self-harm, harm to others, or cyberbullying, and alerts the district to behavior that may be cause for concern.

This service enables school administrators to work alongside families in supporting student safety and well-being in the digital space.

Securly Home is a parent-facing application provided by Securly that allows families to monitor and manage their child's online activity on school-issued devices when at home.
